



CRIA TUITION AND FEES 2018-19

Matriculation Fees

Matriculation Fee must be paid on time no later than **30th March 2018 for returning students**. For new students, matriculation fee needs to be paid 10 business days from the acceptance letter date, or before joining classes upon acceptance after August 1, 2018. Fees in arrears shall incur a 10% penalty and provide no guarantee of a seat for the school year.

Notes:

***The Early Bird Discount** provides a 10% discount on Tuition Fees only, and must be paid by the 30th March for returning students. Early Bird Discount is not available to those who have financial aid/discount provisions in place. Early Bird Discount is available to students who have completed two full years at CRIA and may be utilized only in the third full year of enrollment and beyond; students enrolled in CRIA for the 2017-18 school year are exempt from this requirement.

****Semester and monthly** payment plans include a premium equivalent to 9% P.A. in the installments above. An additional **sibling discount** of 10% for the third child and above pertains to the youngest child(ren) enrolled full-time for tuition only.



One semester tuition fees are 55% of the annual tuition fee. The optional payment plan does not apply for semester fees. Students who enter CRIA the second semester, tuition and all related fees are due again before the start of the first semester of the following school year as normal. Tuition Fees must be paid on time within the tuition payment options schedule above.

Late payments shall incur a 1.5% monthly penalty and will lead to de-enrollment if any portion is unpaid by the last day of each term as per Ministerio de Educacion Publica de Costa Rica decree # 24017. Term end dates for the 2018-19 are announced prior to the start of each school year. All Tuition and Matriculation Fees are non-refundable.

New Family Fee: Grades 1-12

For new families transferring from overseas or home-based schooling, there is a one-time New Family Fee of \$1000 per student enrolled. This fee is for new families who are enrolling students for one term, one semester or full year. For new overseas students who are enrolling at CRIA for less than one full year, the New Family Fee is prorated for the length of the stay (i.e. one term; one semester). New Family Fees are billed upon acceptance along with the Matriculation Fee and are non-refundable.

Billing and Payment

School fees are quoted in US dollars. Payment can be made in colones at the official Banco Central sell-rate or in US dollars. The school business office will only accept checks. CRIA does not accept US dollar checks drawn on banks domiciled outside the USA, except for dollar checks drawn on Banks in Costa Rica. All transfer fees should be paid by the sender. **NOTE: Payment made by deposit in any of the above banks must be identified with the student's name, with a copy sent (by hand or email) to the school business office (506) 2654-5044 or to Margarita Elizondo at m.elizondo@criacademy.com . Matriculation Fee

The Matriculation Fee covers part of the costs of teaching resources for program upgrades and replacement of existing resources. The fee covers both operational and capital costs associated with teaching resources.

- Mandatory Annual Fee for all students Nursery to Grade 12
- **Due Date for returning students: 30th March prior to the August start date**
- Due Date for new students: Upon acceptance and before joining classes
- Fee is non-refundable

Additional Expenses

Additional fees are charged for regular school-to-home transportation, bus service, food service, instrument rentals, some after school activities, field trips other than four selected grade level trips, a copy of the school yearbook and yearbook photos. Students are required to purchase the official P.E. and CRIA school uniform. Additional charges may be levied for consumable materials or special tools in courses like advanced art or math, and for personal reference texts, when required by the school.

Additional fees for special education services or programs outside the program of studies may be required for enrollment at CRIA. Special Education services or programs could include, but are not limited to, special classes in areas such as ESL, foreign languages, specialized arts, learning disabilities, gifted and talented programs, and online courses, special services for students who are learning impaired or who have identified limited special needs.

CRIA pays for MAP and PSAT testing at Director-approved timings each year. SAT or ACT testing is paid for one test per year only for grades 11-12. Any additional external testing per year beyond the one test covered by the school needs to be paid for by the student taking the test.
