The **CRIA Parent Association** works with the goals of fostering a strong school community, enriching our children's learning experience and supporting the school through extracurricular activities and fundraising.

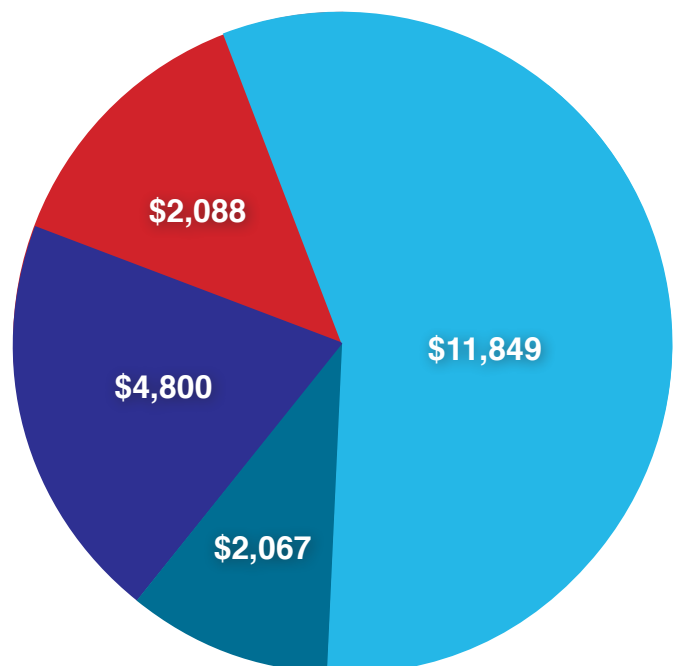
2016/17 Fundraising Efforts

The PA Team worked hard this year to put the “fun” in our **fundraising efforts**, succeeding at raising **\$20,774** to support our school.
