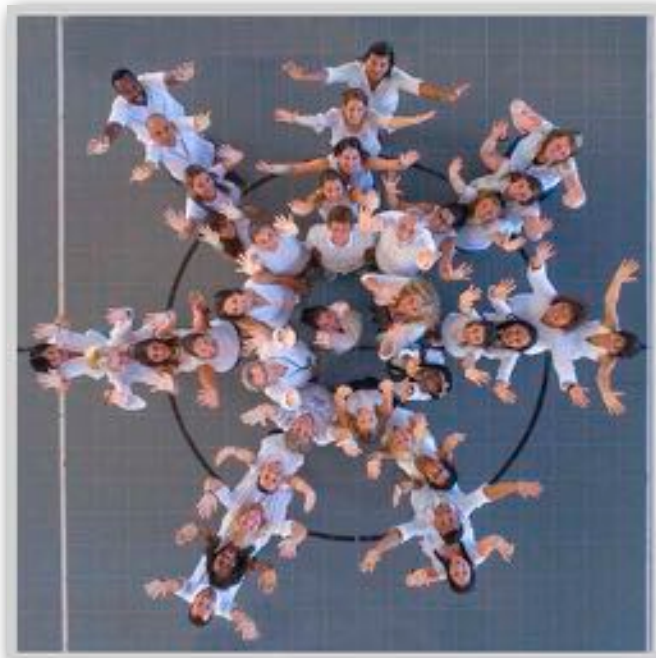

They must also learn the skills of writing in order to communicate those ideas to others. Technology allows students to explore and research on their own, as well as to reach out to others to share ideas. Furthermore students must learn to think creatively in order to be able to see how these ideas can be applied into areas that other less trained minds cannot go. These are the skills that help create the leaders of the future.
