MEP announced today that schools may not return for face-to-face learning for the remainder of 2020. Fortunately, CRIA has prepared for this possible outcome. We are very excited to share with you the news that **CRIA was granted the CAI license** that allows us to offer a program for camp attendees from 2 years old to 12 years old on our spacious campus. In fact, CRIA meets or exceeds all health and facilities standards for a CAI center.

Camp CRIA shall operate only until the CRIA campus has permission to reopen for the normal face-to-face schooling. Details of the program are as follows:

- Camp Term:** September 7 to December 18. See the calendar for holidays and key dates.

- Campers' Ages:** Self-contained Camp Teams are designated by age from 2-12 years old
- Requirements:** Participant must be an enrolled CRIA student in good standing
- Registration:** Registration opens Friday August 28th. **Acceptance is on a first come first served basis. Currently enrolled CRIA students have priority over new transfer students for registration up until Tuesday September 1st.**

CRIA Online Continues

The MEP decision to keep students learning remotely affects CRIA. All of our Pre-K to Grade 12 classes will remain online through the end of the first semester, Dec. 18, 2020. We are hopeful that CRIA students and faculty can resume normal face-to-face learning again in January for the start of the second semester. Our administration and faculty will work together with students and parents to continue to fine tune our remote program.
