Supply List 2024-25 Grades 6-12

Please be sure your child has all items on the list by the first day of school. *Please, label items with an asterisk with your child's name.

General Items required for school:

- CRIA Uniform: CRIA Red polo top and CRIA blue bottoms. Must wear everyday, unless otherwise notified, so it's a good idea to buy multiples of each.
- Backpack, Lunchbox/Snack Box & Reusable Water Bottle*
- Laptop or convertible laptop (see BYOD Policy) and 1 external USB (2GB or more)*
- Headphones*
- Small Lock for locker
- Pencil case of holder for all small supplies to keep organized
- 1 folder with pockets for loose papers
- 5 packs of Post It notes
- Pens and pencils
- Highlighters, a pencil sharpener and erasers
- Glue stick and small scissors
- A small set of colored pencils
- Printer at home (CRIA does not provide printers for student use)
- Internet at home. Many homework assignments require internet access.

Art:

- Sketchbook (9" x 12")
- Black Sharpie

Math and Science:

- 1 Separate 3 ring binder with paper or spiral notebooks 20.5 cm x 26.8 cm (8 in x 11 in) for each subject (separate)
- Ruler, Protractor, Compass and set square (60° & 45°)
- 1 GRID notebook 20.5 cm x 26.8 cm (8 in x 11 in)
- Graph paper (not necessary for 6th grade)
- Calculator–for Algebra 1 and higher, students MUST have a TI-84 graphing calculator. If in Grade 6-8 math (not including Algebra 1), a scientific calculator is required. *

P.E:

- Running or athletic shoes are required for PE. Note that fashion/skateboarding shoes like Converse, Vans, etc
 are not considered running or athletic shoes. Crocs, even when engaged in "sports mode" are unacceptable for
 safety reasons.
- P.E. Uniform Required: CRIA blue top and CRIA red bottoms. Wearing the proper PE uniform is part of our students' grades.

English, Social Science and Spanish:

• 1 Separate 3 ring binder with loose leaf paper or 1 Separate spiral notebooks 20.5 cm x 26.8 cm (8 in x 11 in) for each subject (separate)

STEM 6-8: Pencils (12), Baggies - gallon large, Craft sticks, Colored pencils, Glue sticks, one pack of straws, one roll of masking tape, one roll of scotch tape.
